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Scholarship Agreement From

1. Applicant must sign the Agreement form as a Freshman or within the first year of enrollment at MCISD.
2. Application must be typed and submitted by May 15th to your 4-H or FFA Advisor.
3. Application must be signed by applicant and parent/guardian.
4. Applicant, by signing, agrees to complete 8 hours, over the course of 4 years, with the preparations and/or clean up for the spring social, the fundraiser that generates scholarship monies.
5. Applicant must be a graduating senior from McMullen County High School
6. Applicant must be planning to enroll in an accredited college, university or vocational/technical/trade school.
7. Applicant must have exhibited a project at the McMullen County Livestock Show his/her last four years of high school. In the event of transfer into this school district, a signed affidavit of participation in like event must be presented by the applicant's previous FFA advisor or County Extension Agent. Any applicant that has not exhibited a project for all four years may still apply, but will be required to come before the Fair board to request special consideration. The president of the Fair Board shall determine if a called meeting is warranted.
8. Scholarship funds will be paid out at the rate of \$1000 per semester up to four semesters, or as long as the student is enrolled in school, whichever is less. (Total award amounts will be equally divided between semesters.) For instance, a student in a one-year vocational program would receive \$2000, (2 semesters X \$1000/semester). The first payment will be paid upon presentation of a receipt from the registrar from the respective school and documentation of courses for which the student has registered.
9. Each additional payment as described above will be made upon receipt of the following:
 - a. Certification of grades from the previous semester documenting good scholastic standing.
 - b. Documentation certifying the student's registration for at least the minimum number of class hours to meet the requirements of this scholarship.
 - c. Submit the mailing address and phone number of the Registrar's office so the student's check can be mailed directly to the college.
 - d. Request for payment for summer college attendance will be paid if the student meets the previous requirements and has registered for at least 12 hours for the full summer term or is maintaining fulltime student status.
10. Appropriate documentation and a request for payment of the scholarship must be presented to MCISD scholarship coordinator by September 1 for each fall semester and by January 1 for each spring semester.
11. Scholarships must be fully funded by September 15th, two calendar years following high school graduation or the balance of the scholarship awarded will be forfeited. This allows a grace period of one full college semester to claim the full scholarship awarded.

12. To be in good scholastic standing, the recipient must have earned at least a 2.0 grade point average (GPA) the previous semester on a 4.0 grade scale, completing at least 12 semester hours the previous semester. In addition, the student must register for AND complete a minimum of at least 12 semester hours each semester.
